Closer to Christ Campaign: As mentioned by Fr Stan last week, here is an update of our Parish's decision on the campaign. As you may be aware the Closer to Christ campaign allocates a target amount for each parish to pledge for 5 years. The aim for the diocese is to raise £13.5 million to support our clergy from formation into retirement and support the parishes. Our Parish's share is £90,000 for 5 years of which the diocesan share is £60,300. The remaining £29,7000 is for our own Parish projects. Fr Stan has decided not to go for this approach as he did not want to put the pressure on individual parishioners to make commitment for 5 years towards the campaign.

Instead we have made the commitment to raise the fund for £60,300 and pay £12,060 each year for 5 years towards the campaign fund from the parish account. The contactless machine will have the option for you to pay towards the fund under "Closer to Christ campaign". If you have any fundraising idea's, then please share with Fr Stan and together, we can raise the required funds that we have committed towards the campaign.
